The undersigned agency representative affirms that the above named recruit has undergone a medical examination by a licensed physician and has been approved without any limitations to participate in all physical training and defensive tactics activities during the Police Entry Level Training Program ("PELTP").

The agency representative understands in accordance with the PELTP Rules and Regulations, Section 21, Injuries:

Any recruit injured while participating in any activity during the academy must immediately notify the guest instructor / academy staff of the injury. If the severity of the injury permits, the recruit must submit a "first report of injury report" as soon as possible and in no case later than the beginning of the next workday to the designated academy staff.

The guest instructor / academy staff must verbally notify the Academy Manager immediately of the injury. In addition, the lead instructor must complete a memorandum detailing the injury, which is to be submitted to the Academy Manager no later than the end of the next workday.

The Academy Manager will notify the sponsoring Agency and, if necessary, the emergency contact for the recruit prior to the end of the workday.

If a recruit has restrictions as a result of any injury sustained during the training, the recruit's agency must submit in writing the restrictions and estimated time until the recruit may return to full participation to the Academy Manager or designee. If the injury is too severe to continue training or if the duration of the restrictions is too lengthy to permit full completion during the training, the recruit may be removed from the training class.

Prior to returning to full, "unrestricted," academy activities, the recruit's agency must provide written documentation from the attending physician that the recruit can return to a "full duty status" without limitations to any academy activities.

A recruit shall not feign sickness or disability, nor attempt to deceive an academy staff member concerning that recruit's physical or medical condition.

Failure to comply with any of the above procedures may result in administrative action leading to disciplinary action or a recommendation for dismissal from the academy.
